

MySafeCampus & FIAT

You are encouraged to use MySafeCampus (www.mysafecampus.com or 1.800.716.9007) to report information about any behavior or situation that you believe may be of concern. MySafeCampus allows for confidential reporting – either anonymously or by providing contact information – and is open to all students, faculty, staff, and those coming into contact with the University or its representatives. Calls to the toll-free number are answered by a live agent 24/7, with assistance in more than 160 languages. Information reported on MySafeCampus is routed to the appropriate area for review and follow-up action. For example, information about students is routed to the Vice President for Students while information pertaining to employees is routed to the Vice President of Human Resources.

Concerns reported through MySafeCampus are monitored by the **Franklin Intervention & Awareness Team (FIAT)**. FIAT is a cross-functional team that includes members of the Franklin University faculty and administration. FIAT's primary mission is to promote the health and safety of the entire Franklin community by creating an environment in which development, education, and caring intervention are fostered and encouraged. Other FIAT goals include promoting campus safety by fostering a culture of informing and making our campuses safe environments in which individuals are free to work, learn, and teach unencumbered and uninhibited from threats of intimidation, disruption, or harm.
