



International Student Advisor Report for F-1 Transient Students

A transient student is a student who takes classes simultaneously at two universities. F-1 students are permitted to be transient students and the combination of hours will ensure that full time status is maintained.

8 CFR 214.2 (f) (6) (iv) Concurrent enrollment . An F-1 student may be enrolled in two different Service-approved schools at one time as long as the combined enrollment amounts to a full time course of study. In cases where a student is concurrently enrolled, the school from which the student will earn his or her degree or certification should issue the Form I-20, and conduct subsequent certifications and updates to the Form I-20.

Your current university will keep and maintain your SEVIS I-20 record. Franklin University will not issue you a new I-20.
