Important CLEP Information:

- All CLEP exams cost \$92.
- CLEP exams should be completed at **least one trimester prior** to the term in which the student expects to graduate and should be planned with the student's Academic Advisor.
NOTE: A student may not earn credit through proficiency exams for courses previously attempted, including any courses in which the student has received a failing grade or a 'W' or if it is during or after the second week of the course.
- Students **may** repeat unsuccessful attempts to pass a CLEP after a six-month period.

To Register:

- Students living outside of the central Ohio area will visit the CLEP website (www.collegeboard.com) to locate an official CLEP testing center.
- Central Ohio students will visit the SLC website (www.franklin.edu/slc) to test at the Main Campus.
- GoArmyEd students should speak with their Academic Advisor prior to taking a CLEP examination as registration is different for these students.
