- Face-to-face tutoring appointments are available for Math and Writing. All other face-to-face tutoring is on a walk-in basis only.
- Students are permitted to schedule two appointments per week, per subject either face-to-face or online.

- Students are expected to adhere to the SLC's appointment cancellation policy. **Cancellations must be made two hours prior to the scheduled appointment.**
