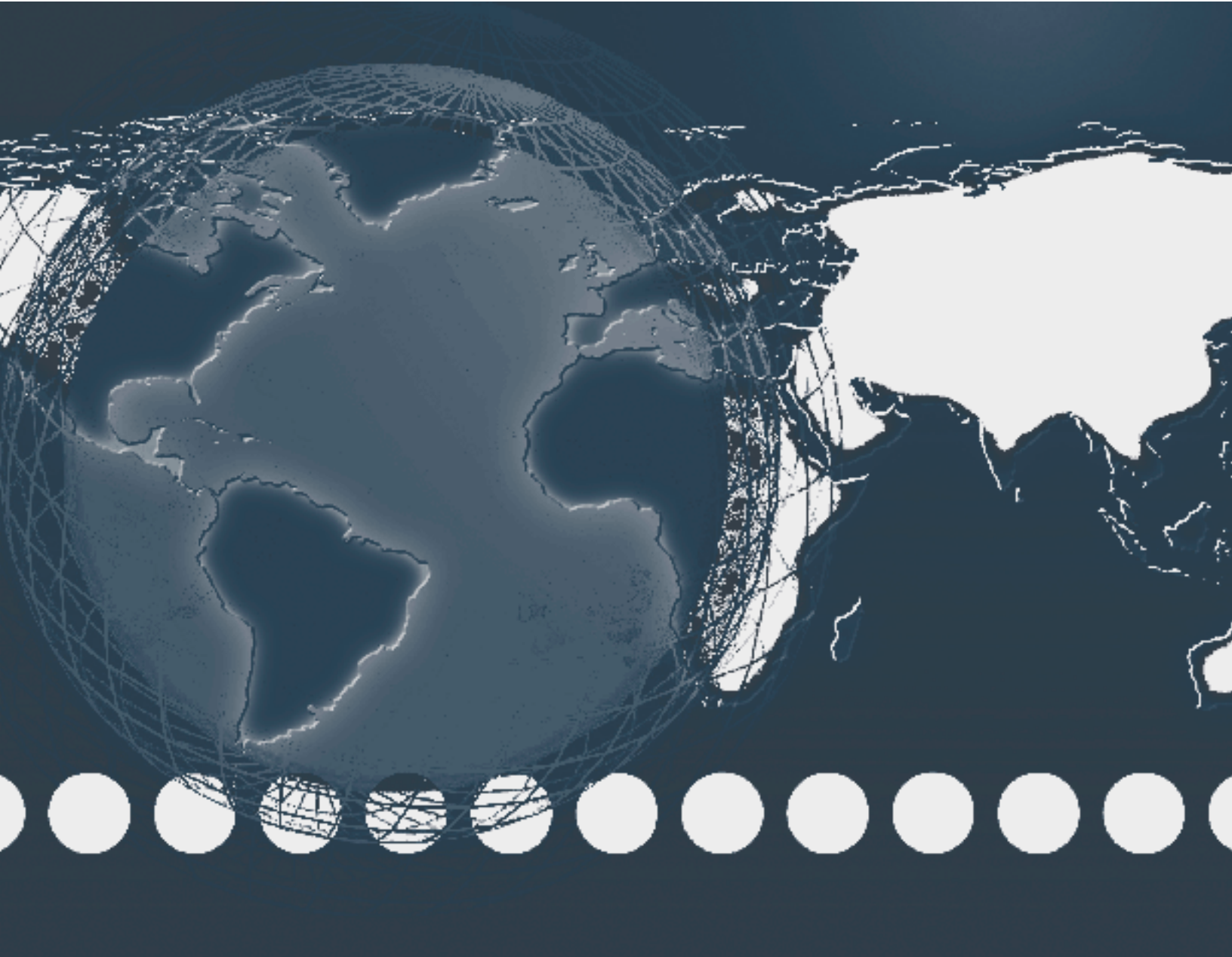

**Students coming from abroad:** Submit supporting documents to the U.S. embassy/consulate when you apply for an entry visa. These should include bank statements, letters from employers stating salaries, and letters of support from sponsors. If your sponsor is a U.S. citizen or permanent resident, he/she should fill out an Affidavit of Support (U.S. Immigration form I-134). You can get this form at any U.S. embassy/consulate, any U.S. Immigration Office or the Office of International Student Services at Franklin University. Submit copies of any available supporting documents with this financial statement to Franklin University. If an F-1 Visa is denied, Franklin University's pre-enrollment tuition payment can be refunded if requested.

**Students transferring from another U.S. college:** Submit all current financial documents you have available from your sponsor. Additional documents may be requested in support of your statement. Contact International Student Services if you have questions.

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** Franklin University's Graduate School does not have financial aid for international students. Under the U.S. Immigration Law, international students with F-1 visas may not work off campus during their first year in the U.S. Franklin University does not guarantee on-campus employment for international students. After the first year, international students can work part time only if they apply to the U.S. Immigration Office for permission. Permission to work part time is granted only in hardship cases where there has been a distinct change of financial circumstances beyond the control of the student. Spouses and/or children of F-1 students are never allowed to work in the U.S.
