Scholarship awards will be automatically renewed for up to 6 consecutive trimesters, pending that the recipient maintains at least a 3.0 Franklin University cumulative GPA, remains in good academic standing and is making continuous progress toward an eligible academic program listed on the Academic Program Scholarship Application. Scholarship recipients must be enrolled in and complete a minimum of 6 credit hours at Franklin University each trimester of consecutive enrollment.
