

# How to use Ebook Central ebooks

These instructions will help you find and use ebooks you can get from Franklin University's library through Ebook Central. You can find more information about using Ebook Central on [Ebook Central's Research Guide](#).

You can get to Ebook Central by [clicking this link](#) or by selecting "databases" on the library's website ([library.franklin.edu](http://library.franklin.edu)) and scrolling down to "ebook central."

## Searching for ebooks

- You may search for ebooks by entering a title, subject or ISBN in the [Ebook Central](#) search bar.
- On the search results screen, you can limit your results by date, subject, or language by checking the boxes on the left side of the screen.

## Reading ebooks

- After you select an ebook, click the Read Online button or click on an area in the table of contents.
- To navigate through the book, use arrows on the upper right corner or use the search within book box on the left side of the screen.

## Ebook Central account

- An Ebook Central account allows you to save ebooks to your bookshelf, save searches, and add notes to ebooks.
- You will be prompted to create an EBook Central account when copying, printing, or downloading. Click the Join Ebook Central link to create your account. An account is required to copy, print, or download Ebook Central ebooks.

## Copying/Printing/Downloading

- *Chapter Downloads*
  - You may download chapters by clicking on the Chapter Download link. You will need to login to print, copy, or download pages. The publisher for each book sets the page limits for printing, copying, and downloading.
- *Downloading an entire book*
  - If the ebook is available for download, click the Full Download link. You will be prompted to select your device.
    - For downloading on multiple devices, you will need an Adobe ID and the Adobe Digital Editions software.
    - For downloading on mobile devices, you will need the BlueFire Reader Software and an Adobe ID.
- Downloading rights are on a book-by-book basis.
