



## F-1 TRANSIENT STUDENT FORM

A transient student is a student who enrolls at one institution to transfer credits to their home institution, often while on a break from their home institution or taking classes simultaneously at the two institutions. Under 8 CFR 214.2 (f) (6) (iv), credits earned at Franklin by F-1 students may be applicable to full-time enrollment requirements at their home institution for the purpose of maintaining F-1 status; F-1 students should consult the international student advisor at their home institution for more information.

Please complete the following form and submit it to the Office of International Students and Programs each term you will be enrolled at Franklin University as a transient student. Your home institution will keep and maintain your SEVIS record. Franklin University will not issue you a new I-20 unless you apply for admission to Franklin as a degree-seeking F-1 student and transfer your SEVIS record to Franklin.
