Important CLEP Information:

- CollegeBoard charges \$85 per CLEP voucher. Each individual approved testing site may charge an additional administration fee assessed per test. (The Testing Center charges an administration fee of \$25)
- CLEP exams should be completed **at least one trimester prior** to the term in which the student expects to graduate and should be planned with the student's Academic Advisor.
NOTE: A student may not earn credit through proficiency exams for courses previously attempted, including any courses in which the student has received a failing grade or a 'W' or if it is during or after the second week of the course.
- Students **may** repeat unsuccessful attempts to pass a CLEP after 90 days.

- Students will visit the CLEP website (www.collegeboard.com) to locate an official CLEP testing center and purchase an exam voucher.
- Central Ohio students can schedule to test at the Testing Center on Main Campus by visiting our website (www.franklin.edu/slc).
