## Important DSST Information:

- Students will pay a \$85 DSST charge and a \$27 administration fee assessed per test taken at the Testing Center.
- DSST exams should be completed **at least one trimester prior** to the term in which the student expects to graduate and should be planned with the student's Academic Advisor.  
*NOTE: A student may not earn credit through proficiency exams for courses previously attempted, including any courses in which the student has received a failing grade or a 'W' or if it is during or after the second week of the course.*
- Students **may** repeat unsuccessful attempts to pass a DSST after 90 days.

- Students living outside of the central Ohio area will visit the DSST website ([www.getcollegetest.com](http://www.getcollegetest.com)) to locate an official DSST testing center.
- Central Ohio students will visit the testing center website ([www.franklin.edu/current-students/learning-support/testing/proficiency-testing](http://www.franklin.edu/current-students/learning-support/testing/proficiency-testing)) to test at the Main Campus.
- Active Military students should speak with their Academic Advisor prior to taking a DSST examination as registration is different for these students.
- You will pay for your DSST at your testing site.
