

WEBD 101 Study Guide for FUPE

Format

The FUPE exam for WEBD101 is an online exam. You will have up to 2 hours (120 minutes) to take the exam. It is worth up to 100 points. You must get an 80% or above to pass this FUPE.

There are 50 total questions on this exam. There are 35 multiple choice questions worth 2 points each and 15 short answer/essay questions worth 2 points each for a total of 100 points.
