#### **Award**

Franklin's CBusStudentHack Scholarship is a non-refundable award available to new degree-seeking students that have graduated from high school within the past 4 years, have no more than 12 college credits earned (excluding AP and/or CCP credit), and who participate and successfully complete a Franklin University and AT&T sponsored CBusStudentHack experience. For bachelor's degree applicants, a maximum scholarship of \$30,000, awarded in increments of \$3,750 per trimester for up to eight trimesters can be awarded. For associate's degree applicants, a maximum scholarship of \$15,000, awarded in increments of \$3,750 per trimester for up to four trimesters can be awarded. The scholarship can be used for tuition only and cannot be combined with any other Franklin University scholarships or discounts. This scholarship automatically renews for up to eight terms (bachelor's degree) or four terms (associate's degree) of enrollment, pending that the recipient meets all conditions outlined in the Scholarship Agreement.

### Scholarship Eligibility

- New degree-seeking student that has graduated from high school within the past 4 years, and has no more than 12 college credits earned (excluding AP and/or CCP credit), who will be seeking a degree in one of the following:
  - Web Development, Information Technology, Information Systems, Health Information Management, Computer Science, or Cyber Security
- Minimum high school cumulative GPA of 2.75
- Recommendation by a CBusStudent Hack advisor
- Validated successful completion of a Franklin University and AT&T sponsored CBusStudentHack experience
- Enrollment in a minimum of 12 credit hours for each term awarded, maintaining a 2.75 cumulative GPA
- U.S. citizen or permanent resident of the United States
- Completion and submission of the Scholar Information and Scholarship Acceptance form is required before funds can be credited to the recipient's account
