SPRING 2023 HIGHLIGHTS

SUPPORTING EVERY STUDENT

The Franklin University Learning Commons worked on several projects during the Spring 2023 term to improve the student experience, expand services, and support academic programs including:

GUARDIAN BROWSER IMPLEMENTATION

Franklin University's online proctoring service, ProctorU, has developed a new proprietary lockdown browser called Guardian Browser. We initiated the use of this new browser starting in Summer 2023.

The browser will be more secure than the former extension iteration of ProctorU, featuring enhanced security through virtual machine detection as well as a third-party restriction to reduce content theft. Improved test-taker experience is anticipated as well, with familiar downloading steps for each test, quick support access through a built-in chat feature, and accessibility tools.

FRANKLIN ARCHIVES DIGITIZATION

We are actively digitizing our archival collection. New collections have been added focusing on the buildings and grounds, Franklin alumni, commencement, and student newspapers. All collections can be accessed via our new **Archives & Special Collections** page.

ACADEMIC SUPPORT ACHIEVEMENTS

To ensure our academic support services are meeting the needs of students and achieving the intended outcomes, a study showed the following:

- Students who use tutoring that pass at the same rate or higher rate than those who do not use tutoring increased by **3.7%**.
- Student who use tutoring and remained at Franklin at the same rate or higher than those who do not use tutoring increased by **2.5%**.
- 86% of students self-reported increased confidence and ability to complete coursework.

Based on the national average, students have saved over an estimated \$3 million on textbooks since the library and OER textbook program began in Fall 2018.



42k+

As of Spring 2023, 42,266 textbook purchases were replaced by library or OER textbooks since the program began in 2018.



During the Spring 2023 semester, there were over 32,720 visits to the Learning Commons website.



Library users accessed over 55,000 unique titles via online PDFs or web based resources in Spring 2023.

REFERENCE DATA HIGHLIGHTS

REFERENCE SERVICES DATA DASHBOARD

In an effort to better understand our reference services impact on students, we regularly collect reference data. We've highlighted a few areas below.



We receive questions in a variety of formats, including email, phone, chat, and in person. For SP23, **75.9%** of reference questions were answered via chat.



We answer questions for student, faculty, staff, community patrons and more. In SP23, approximately **43%** of questions came from undergraduate students.



Students ask us several different types of questions. Below you can see that for SP23 Reference & Research questions were the majority, with questions regarding APA coming in second.



ADDITIONAL HIGHLIGHTS



LIBRARY

- In SP23, 166 courses were using Free via Library etextbooks, with 344 sections using 200 books.
- Research Services Data
 - 104 hours of team working 1:1 with students.
 - 61% of reference questions are asked via live chat.
 - 241 chats averaging 15 minutes.



TESTING CENTER

- Testing supported a total of 2,131 Franklin testers in SP23.
- \$5,124 in earned revenue for SP23.
- A total of 3,428 ProctorU exams were completed in SP23.



TUTORING

- For SP23, the Learning Commons conducted 950 tutoring appointments.
- We saw a 20% increase YOY in the number of students who utilized tutoring during the spring term.
- 90 Smarthinking tutoring sessions.
- 758 papers were reviewed by the Online Writing Review in SP23.
