DECLARATION OF FINANCIAL SPONSORSHIP

Students intending to enter the U.S. on an F-1 visa and/or attend Franklin University in F-1 immigration status must demonstrate that they have access to sufficient funding for at least the first year of their studies. **Students who will be self-sponsoring must demonstrate at least two years of funding.** The Office of International Students and Programs (OISP) sets minimum financial requirements based on the University's tuition rates and estimated living expenses. Students who are unable to demonstrate sufficient funding are eligible to be admitted to the University but will not be eligible to apply for an F-1 visa or immigration status.

Financial Responsibility Statement

I understand the following information:

- Students are responsible for all expenses incurred at Franklin University, and tuition is due at the beginning of each term.
- Maintaining F-1 immigration status and legal presence in the U.S. requires students to enroll in courses. Students with unpaid balances will not be eligible for enrollment.
- Tuition and fees are subject to change.
- F-1 students have limited work authorization in the United States and cannot be
 expected to earn sufficient funding for more than discretionary expenses if
 authorized for employment in the U.S.
- Financial statements must include the account holder's name, statement issuance date, amount of available funds, and currency.
- Statement issuance dates should be as recent as possible and will not be accepted if more than six months old.
- Your sponsor must certify that sufficient funds will be available for the duration of your program, and financial statements must verify that the minimums funds are immediately accessible.
- The sponsor financially responsible for the student must be the account holder named on the financial statements and authorized to share the documents.
