- Required hours of enrollment for all scholarships listed are for Franklin hours only.
- To be competitive, students must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher (see specific scholarship requirements).
- In general, students must enroll for a minimum of six credit hours at Franklin University (see specific scholarship requirements).
- Students must submit a typed essay with the application. Please choose one essay topic from the following essay choices listed below. Essay should be a maximum of 500 words in length; 2 pages, double spaced. Please note that certain scholarships have additional essay requirements that should be incorporated into one single essay. Only one essay is required.
- If an essay is not submitted with the application, your application will not be considered.
- Please choose one essay topic:

- 1. How has your family background affected the way you see the world?
- 2. Does any attribute, quality, or skill distinguish you from everyone else? How did you obtain or develop this characteristic and what role will it have in helping you to accomplish your goals at Franklin University and your professional goals?
- 3. Define empathy and what role it plays within the classroom and professional setting.

- If you are applying for the Charles R Brush (CRB), Mary S. Brush (MSB) or the Carl E. Conrad Endowed (CCS) scholarships, include an essay with the following topic:

What are your short and long term goals, what brought you to Franklin University and how will this scholarship make a difference in accomplishing your goals?

- Franklin University employees, their spouses, and/or dependents are not eligible to apply if they are currently receiving tuition benefits.
- The majority of undergraduate scholarship awards are for tuition and fees only at Franklin. Awards will be applied toward tuition beginning with the first trimester for which this application is submitted.
